From writing proposals, to pitching in front of a panel, English Language skills set you up with loads of information on both planning and organising your ideas.

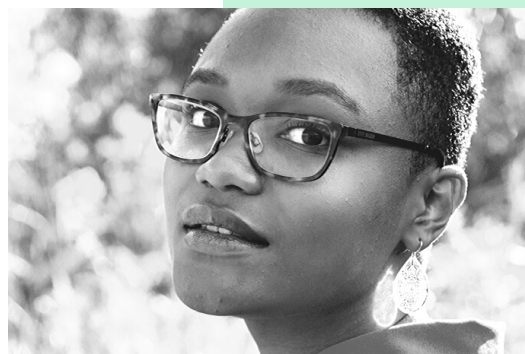
Remember to make sure what you write has accurate spelling, punctuation and grammar.
